History

Medicine Park came to life in 1908 as a private resort established by Elmer Thomas, who gained recognition as a US Senator. The original community had many prominent citizens including doctors, lawyers and politicians and their families. The well regarded Oklahoma Editor's Club also chose this idealic setting. Others came for the healing waters of Medicine Creek and stayed at Dr. Baird's Sanatorium. Through the history of the Park nearby Fort Sill, found recreation in the Park. Anchored by the Wichita Mountains National Refuge with Medicine Creek running through the center the Park continues to be the destination for those seeking a unique get-away.
